IMPORTANT NOTICE

On **Wednesday**, **July 9**, **2025 beginning at 7:00AM**, Ward Two Water District will be making repairs to a fire hydrant in your area. In doing so, your water service will be temporarily interrupted during this process.

Louisiana Department of Health requires all water systems to do a Boil Advisory if the water pressure goes below the Louisiana Department of Health minimum standard.

In order to make these connections/repairs, the water pressure will be reduced below the minimum standard set by Louisiana Department of Health.

This Advisory is limited to customers on Magnolia Beach Road (LA-64) from Old River Road (LA-1028) to LA Highway 16.

Therefore, as a precaution, the Ward Two Water District water system will be issuing a BOIL ADVISORY effective when you lose water pressure on **Wednesday**, **July 9**, **2025**. This BOIL ADVISORY will remain in effect until rescinded by Ward Two Water District.

It is recommended that all customers disinfect their water before consuming it (including fountain drinks), making ice, brushing teeth, or using it for food preparation or rinsing of foods by the following means:

Boil water for one (1) full minute in a clean container. The one minute starts after the water has been brought to a rolling boil. The flat taste can be eliminated by shaking the water in a clean bottle or pouring it from one clean container to another.

Upon notification from the Office of Public Health's State Regional Laboratory that the samples collected from our water supply have been found to be safe, the State Health Department will notify the water supply of the sample results. Upon such notification, Ward Two Water District will then rescind the BOIL ADVISORY and notify its customers that the water has been found to be safe.
