

IMPORTANT NOTICE

On **Tuesday, September 1, 2026**, Ward Two Water District will be in your area making a permanent repair to the water main damaged on August 10, 2026. In doing so, your water service will be temporarily interrupted during this process.

Louisiana Department of Health requires all water systems to do a Boil Advisory if the water pressure goes below the Louisiana Department of Health minimum standard.

To make these repairs, the water pressure will be reduced below the minimum standard set by Louisiana Department of Health.

Therefore, as a precaution, if/when you lose water pressure on **Tuesday, September 1, 2026**, Ward Two Water District will issue a Boil Advisory for **those on Crossover Road from Dunn Road to Seagull Lane ONLY, EXCLUDING: Dunn Road and Seagull Lane.**

Additional calls, texts, and email notifications will be sent out, and our website will be updated once the Boil Advisory is issued. **If you wish to receive such notifications, please call (225) 665-5188 to update your records.**

This Boil Advisory will remain in effect until rescinded by the Ward Two Water District water system.

It is recommended that all customers disinfect their water before consuming it (including fountain drinks), making ice, brushing teeth, or using it for food preparation or rinsing of foods by the following means:

Boil water for one (1) full minute in a clean container. The one minute starts after the water has been brought to a rolling boil. The flat taste can be eliminated by shaking the water in a clean bottle or pouring it from one clean container to another.

Again, please be sure to disinfect your own water prior to consumption until you have been advised otherwise.

Upon notification from the Office of Public Health's State Regional Laboratory that the samples collected from our water supply have been found to be safe, the State Health Department will notify the water supply of the sample results. Upon such notification, Ward Two Water District will then rescind the Boil Advisory and notify its customers that the water has been found to be safe.
